THIS PERMIT IS GIVEN SUBJECT TO CITY OF BRIDGEPORT ORDINANCES AND SPECIFICATIONS GOVERNING SIDEWALK, CURB AND DRIVEWAY APPROACHES AS FOLLOWS:

1. Only Contractors licensed by the Public Facilities Department, City of Bridgeport, shall be issued permits to work on sidewalks, curbs or driveway approaches.
2. Contractors shall not be issued permits without a clearance notification from the of the City Engineer.
3. Contractors shall maintain permit at construction site when excavation is begun and shall display same to Public Facilities Representative when requested.
4. If permit encompasses a corner, Contractor shall comply with State of Connecticut Public Act No. 77- 385 concerning handicap curb cuts.
5. Any person or contractor violating City of Bridgeport Ordinances concerning sidewalk, curb, driveway approaches or other provisions in this permit shall be fined up to one hundred dollars (\$100.00) per business day till violation is rectified.
6. All contractors installing concrete curbs, sidewalks, drive approaches shall inform Public Facilities Department for inspection at least 24 hours before pouring concrete. Please call! 576-7790 for inspection.
7. Any contractor working on a corner where a signal light controls will inform Public Facilities Department before demolition of sidewalk. Please call 576-7751.
