There will be a Public Hearing of the City of Bridgeport's CITIZENS' ADVISORY COMMITTEE, to be held on Wednesday, May 20, 2015, at 6:00 PM, at Littlefield Recital Hall, University of Bridgeport, Iranistan and University Avenue, Bridgeport, Connecticut.

PUBLIC HEARING OF CITIZENS' ADVISORY COMMITTEE - MAY 20, 2015

The purpose of the Public Hearing is to elicit opinions of Bridgeport residents regarding: (1) the Resolution of the City Council regarding the Bridgeport Harbor Station and the "phase-out" of coal-fired electricity generation at the Bridgeport Harbor Station at the earliest possible date" and (2) the terms and provisions of a community environmental benefit agreement as anticipated by C.G.S. §22a-20a(c). Such agreements address the issue of mitigation of the impact of the construction of a new combined cycle power plant. The Public Hearing will consider ideas pertaining to "...on-site and off-site improvements, activities and programs, including, but not limited to: Funding for activities, such as environmental education, diesel pollution reduction, construction of biking and walking trails, staffing for parks, urban forestry, support for community gardens or any other negotiated benefits for the environment in the environmental justice community".
