General schedule for **after-school** (3:00 pm - 5:30 pm):

- 15 minutes of a Nutritional Snack
- 1 hour Homework Help
- 1 hour of Enrichment Activities

The cost for the after-school program is **\$5 - \$20 per week per child** depending on household income. Fees subject to change. A \$25 non-refundable deposit is due at registration. Scholarship funding is available.

(Late pick-up option available for an additional fee)

General schedule for **summer program** (9:00 am - 5:00 pm):

- 20 minutes of a Nutritional Breakfast
- 2.5 hours Summer Learning in Literacy and Math
- 30 minutes Nutritional Lunch
- 4.5 hours of Enrichment Activities

The cost for the summer program is **\$10 - \$40 per week per child** depending on household income. Fees subject to change. A \$25 non-refundable deposit is due at registration. Scholarship funding is available.

(Early drop-off and late pick-up option is available for an additional fee)

Other Components:

TEEN TRAINING & EMPLOYMENT

This program places qualifying youth ages 14-21 in jobs during the summer.

Youth selected for employment are trained in areas related to job readiness skills, working with younger children, preparing resumes, conflict resolution, and team building strategies.

MUSIC & ARTS PARTNERSHIP

A collaboration between the Lighthouse Program and MACH whereby participating students are enriched through the arts.



SUPPLEMENTAL EDUCATIONAL SERVICES

The Lighthouse Program is an approved provider of supplemental educational services and offers tutoring to qualifying Bridgeport K-8 students in Reading and Mathematics. Certified teachers and Bachelor Degree staff tutor students with prescribed curriculum aligned with Connecticut standards in 1 hour sessions per day, 3-4 times per week in individual or small group settings.
