Connecticut State Median Income: 2016

State Median Income is established by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services. These guidelines are used to determine income eligibility for various local, state, and federal programs.

For most programs that use SMI for eligibility, the income chart is effective July 1-June 30 of each year.

\$5.00 per week if under 30% state median

\$10.00 per week if over 30% state median but below 40%

\$15.00 per week if over 40% state median but below 50%

\$20.00 per week of over 50% state median income

Optional (After school only)

\$2.00 per day late pick-up at 6pm regardless of sliding scale status

Summer 2017 Fees per Child

\$10.00 per week if under 30% state median income

\$20.00 per week if over 30% state median but below 40%

\$30.00 per week if over 40% state median but below 50%

\$40.00 per week if over 50% state median income
